

# DOMAINE DE PERDRYCOURT



## CHABLIS GRAND CRU

Les Clos  
100% Chardonnay



**VINEYARD:** vines located on the right bank of the River Serein in Chablis. It is the largest of the seven Grands Crus with a regular 200-meter South-West facing slope.

**TERROIR:** grey rendzines overlie Kimmeridgian marl slopes. Heavy soil.

**VINIFICATION:** manual harvest. Alcoholic fermentation in young barrels during 1 or 2 weeks. Aged on full lees during 22 months with regular stirring and pumping-over of the must to lend richness.

**TASTING:** with its beautiful gold color, the wine is bold, full and mineral. Round and rich, the oak gives some buttered notes and a good length.

A long toasted finish.

The wine's firm structure ensures good ageing potential.

**ACCOMPANYING:** Serve with all delicate meals such as fish, scallop shell, fish and hen breast.

**TEMPERATURE:**

12 -14°C
